Thank you for your interest in applying for the Leonard H.A. Franz Scholarship offered by the Plumas Association of REALTORS®.

Following are the criteria on which the Plumas Association of REALTORS® Scholarship Committee will evaluate your application:

- Academic record
- School activities
- Community service
- Work experience (paid or unpaid)
- Personal statement
- Being a member of a PAR REALTOR® family (not required)

Six monetary awards will be given to a six **graduating seniors planning to attend a two-year or four-year college or vocational/technical school.**

One scholarship will be dedicated to an applicant (from any of the five high schools) that will be attending a **trade/technical or vocational school**. The other five scholarships will be awarded to one student from each of five schools/community areas. Applicants must have attended **Quincy, Portola, Chester, Greenville, or Loyalton High School**, or the affiliated Charter or Christian schools in those communities for at least four (4) semesters (junior and senior year). Applicants must have a 3.0 or above grade point for their high school average. Applicants should provide a log of hours and activities to support their community service and work experience (paid or unpaid) activities.

In an effort to be totally impartial, the Scholarship Committee wishes to review all qualifications of applicants without associating names with the applications. Therefore, you are requested to indicate your name, address, and other pertinent information on the last page of the Scholarship Application where indicated. (If needed, our staff will amend your parts of your application to hide your name.)
